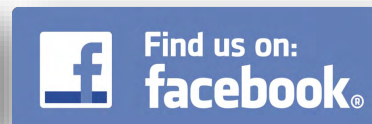

[Menchville House](#), a 501(c) 3 organization, is a forty-six-bed emergency housing facility for homeless families located in the Denbigh area of Newport News.

Menchville House started in April 1998 as the vision of three women to establish a shelter for homeless women and their children. The agency works with other homeless service providers and social service agencies that offer families the services and support needed to return to self-sufficiency. Since 1998, over 4,000 families have moved from hurt to hope to become healthy, independent, and contributing members of their communities.

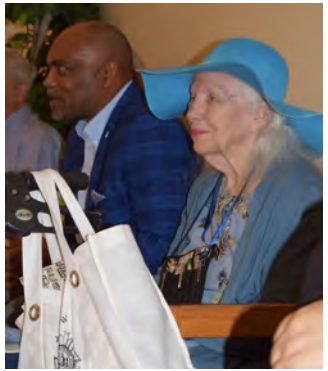

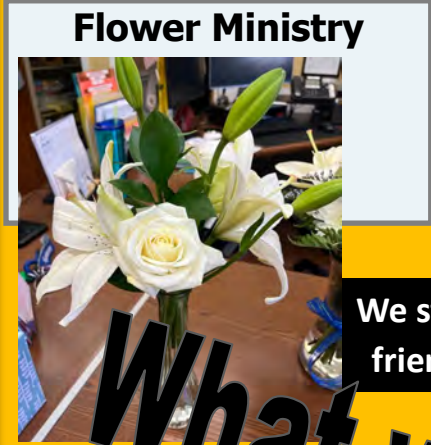
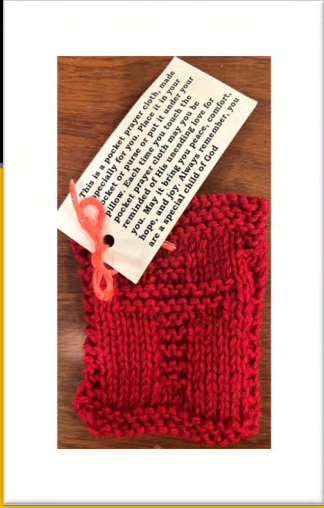
