# **Recipe of the Month** Church Member: Pauline Springer

SHORTBREAD
(Recipe from the Glasgow Cookery Book)
1 cup all purpose Flour
1 Stick of butter
¼ cup of granulated sugar
Ingredients can be easily doubled or tripled
Turn on Oven to 325 degrees F.
Mix flour and sugar
Work flour and sugar into butter using your hands
Using a Food Processor makes this much easier and quicker
Make sure it is kneaded well and shape into pan
You can press into a 9" pie pan or press or roll into a rectangle on sheet pan,
You want dough to be a little less than ½ inch thick
Pinch edges or use a fork to press edges.
Prick the top with a fork, sprinkle lightly with sugar
Bake until pale brown
Allow to cool for a short time before moving
Cut into pieces before cold
Enjoy.


